

# VIBE CODING: READY-TO-USE CREATIVE PROMPTS

Vibe coding is about starting with intent, mood, and outcome instead of technical constraints. The prompts below are designed to spark ideas quickly and help you generate functional, visually appealing products—from apps to websites to presentations.

## How to Use These Prompts

Start with the vibe, focus on outcomes, guide structure and tone, and iterate quickly.

Use these prompts as-is or adapt them to your own tools, workflows, or creative goals.

- Build a simple **expense tracker app** where users can log expenses, choose categories (food, transport, entertainment), and view a monthly spending summary in chart format. Include a clean, minimal design with easy navigation and a dashboard view.
- Create a **habit tracker mobile app** with daily check-in buttons, streak counters, and weekly progress graphs. Allow users to customize habits (e.g., exercise, reading, meditation) and send daily motivational reminders.
